

When your water heater stops working, it can quickly disrupt your daily routine. Whether you're facing a cold shower or no hot water for washing dishes, identifying the root cause is the first step to restoring comfort to your home. Below, we'll explore common reasons why your water heater might not be functioning and what you can check before calling in a professional.





### 1. NO HOT WATER

### **Possible Causes:**

### **Power Supply Issues**

- If you have an electric water heater, check the circuit breaker. A tripped breaker will cut power to the unit. Reset it if needed.
- For gas water heaters, ensure the pilot light is lit. If it's out, relight it following the manufacturer's instructions.

### **Faulty Thermostat**

 A broken thermostat can prevent the water heater from heating properly. Test the thermostat and replace it if necessary.

### **Heating Element Failure**

• In electric models, a failed heating element can stop water from warming up. These components can wear out over time and may need replacement.

# 2. INCONSISTENT OR INSUFFICIENT HOT WATER

### **Possible Causes:**

### Sediment Build-Up

• Over time, minerals from hard water can accumulate in the tank, reducing its efficiency and capacity. Draining and flushing the tank can help.

### Thermostat Settings

• Ensure the thermostat is set to the desired temperature, typically around 120°F to 140°F.

#### **Tank Size**

• If you consistently run out of hot water, your water heater might not be large enough for your household's needs. ### **Sediment Buildup**

• Electric water heaters may produce a humming noise if the heating element is loose or failing.

## 5. DISCOLORED OR SMELLY WATER

### **Possible Causes:**

### **Rusty Water**

• Rust-colored water may indicate corrosion in the tank or pipes. Installing an anode rod can help extend the life of your water heater.

#### **Foul Odor**

• A rotten egg smell usually indicates bacterial growth inside the tank. Flushing the tank and treating it with hydrogen peroxide or another approved cleaner can help.
